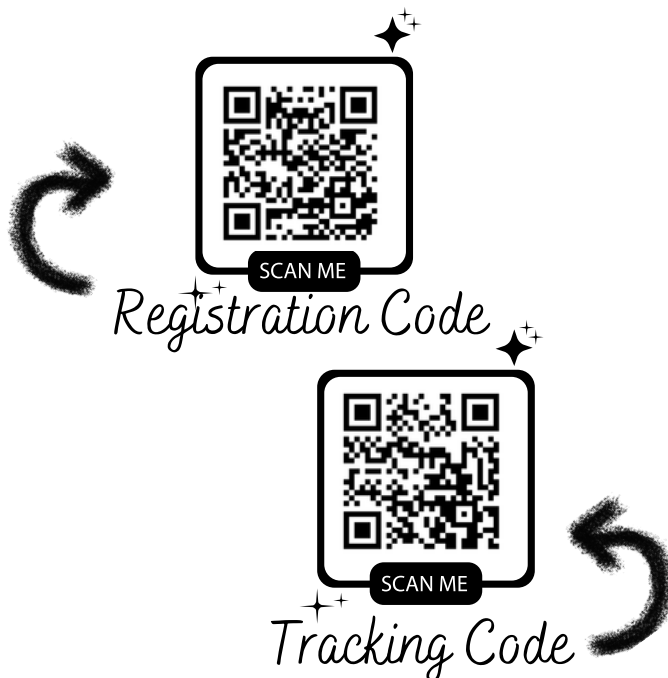

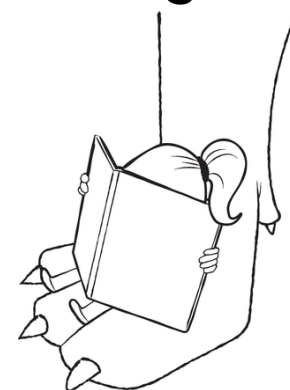
## How does Summer Learning work at Brentwood Library?
